Position

*CO for
Outreach & Special Projects*

Requirements

- *The CO for Outreach and Special Projects shall have attended at least one regional or NACURH conference.*
- *Live in housing that is owned and operated by your college or university housing department throughout their term of office, excluding summer and winter breaks.*
- *Shall be a student school in good standing.*
- *Must maintain full-time student status for the entirety of their terms of office.*
- *Cannot hold both a Regional Board of Directors position and a conference team position or CC position.*
- *Have a 2.5 GPA on a 4 point scale. If you are unsure of the GPA equivalency of a 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, please email the Regional Director at gl_director@nacurh.org.*

Duties

- *Maintain contact with RHA presidents.*
- *Create bi-monthly newsletter for both RHA & NRHH presidents.*
- *Educate on regional philanthropy.*
- *Coordinate philanthropy initiatives.*
- *Assist in program development.*
- *Carry out orders of director.*
- *Work with NAN & AD-NRHH to do special projects on the NACURH level.*
- *Conduct assessment surveys on years that they are needed.*

Advice from Past CO for OSP

A person bidding for this position should consider themselves to be an adaptable and flexible person, especially because special projects can arise during the year. In this position, strong communication skills are necessary in maintaining outreach with presidents and other various colleagues in NACURH. You should also consider yourself organized due to the nature of the position having a variety of tasks, and you will need to keep the different duties separate and orderly. Some of the largest tasks that would require the most time afforded would be the production of the bi-monthly newsletter, and working with the Regional Philanthropy to encourage participation from member schools.
