 - Proponent speech

 - Indiana University Purdue University Indianapolis (IUPUI) moves to end Q & A
 - Seconded by Oakland University (OU) with no objections
 - Discussion
 - Western Michigan University (WMU) feels that this candidate is qualified and that the RBD is qualified for finding a regional advisor and has made a good decision.
 - Northern Illinois University (NIU) feels that he'll be a great fit with his passion for students.
 - Wayne State University (WSU) feels he will be passionate for this organization.
 - University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee (UW-M) feels that there has been a good turnout and that Brian is a good candidate.
 - Purdue University (PU) move to end discussion
 - Seconded by Saginaw Valley State University (SVSU) with no objections
 - Vote: 34-0-5

- Direct Elect Selection Process
 - Proponent Speech
 - Q & A
 - WMU: Could you describe the candidate's diversity aspect?
 - She's focused a lot of time as a social justice scholar at IUPUI and she has talked about creating guides and working with the RBD to create an inclusive environment for the region.
 - Marquette University (MU): Do you [the RBD] feel confident that she can balance her time commitments?
 - Yes, she creates schedules, she expressed all her current involvements and future ones as well, and how she's able to balance all of that between her days.
 - Indiana University – Bloomington (IU-B): can you clarify what a social justice scholar is and how she plans to get involved on campus?
 - Philanthropic projects for the entire campus and works with underrepresented populations on campus. Holds programs to help support social justice issues.
 - SVSU: Does she have any personal goals or objectives not outlined in the position?
 - Yes she touched on her personal goals and she's going into student affairs, she talked about wanting to grow with the board and develop more skills with the NBD and gaining those communication skills and representing the region on a larger scale.
 - WMU: It was discussed that she put on social justice programs. Can you tell us what?
 - She did not elaborate on those so we can't discuss those items.
 - WMU: What conferences has she needed to attend to be Director?
 - She's attended 6 conferences total.
 - Southern Illinois University – Carbondale (SIU-C): She has plans to take an active role, what are they?
 - She discussed working with the RBD and working on the regional goals of them. She explained she wants to be involved on the team and achieve all of their goals and be active and represent everyone on the NBD.
 - OU moves to extend by 5 minutes
 - Seconded by WMU with no objections
 - UW-M: How will she balance her professional and personal life with all of her obligations?
 - She talked about self-care, and how she plans/schedules items on her board. She's big on self-care and balancing those duties as a Director.
 - University of Wisconsin – Eau Claire (UW-EC) moves to end discussion
 - 2nd by Manchester University (MU) with no objections

- Discussion
 - University of Wisconsin – Green Bay (UW-GB) feels this candidate is passionate and socially inclusive and will bring a lot.
 - IU-B feels that she's involved herself and that we should accept her.
 - University of Evansville (UE) believes that the success of her previous responsibilities is important and matters for this position.
 - NIU is in full support for her passion for the region and the resources for the member schools.
 - MU feels that this individual is successful and has a diverse background with her prior responsibilities.

 - She will be a fourth year at SVSU, she was taking 15 credits a semester, as well as an RA, and in RHA/NRHH.
 - IUPUI: What are her goals?
 - Her goals are to work with conference programming chairs to ensure programming sessions are diverse and quality programs for the region.
