



Main Motion T | Voting Membership Adjustments

Whereas, GLACURH values NRHH and creating a more inclusive and equitable environment for NRHH chapters and NRHH-Communications Coordinators (NRHH-CCs), and;

Whereas, language indicates the values of an organization, and can be incredibly important in maintaining a priority of respect and inclusion, and;

Whereas, GLACURH has institutions that have chartered NRHH chapters, but not affiliated RHAs, which means their primary voting representative is an NRHH-CC, and;

Whereas, as the GLACURH governing documents read currently, institutions that only have an NRHH chapter would technically be excluded from the voting membership of the region, and;

Whereas, the region does not exclude these member schools from voting membership, which makes practice and policy dissonant, then;

Therefore let it be resolved, that Title 2, Article VII, Sections 1 and 2 be updated to reflect the following immediately following the close of the Regional Business Conference.

Article VII	Voting Membership
Section 1	Each member school <u>shall have up to one National Communication Coordinator (NCC), who represents their institution in joint and NCC boardrooms, and up to one NRHH-Communications Coordinator (NRHH-CC), who represents their institution in NRHH boardroom.</u> shall select an individual to represent it on a regional and national level. This individual shall be titled the National Communications Coordinator (NCC) and shall carry out all duties as specified in the by-laws. 1. <u>In cases where an institution only has an affiliated NRHH chapter, the NRHH-CC will represent their institution in joint boardroom.</u>
Section 2	The NCCs of all <u>One Communications Coordinator from each</u> member schools in good standing shall make up the voting membership of GLACURH.
Section 3	Quorum shall be defined as 50% plus one (1) of the voting membership of GLACURH.
